MASTERS PENNANTS:

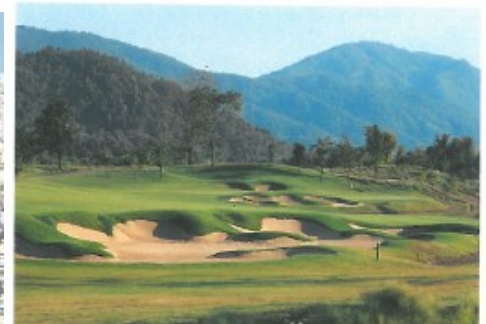
